

PROPERTY TAX RELIEF

Seniors may be eligible for property tax relief through the NJ State program, Property Tax Reimbursement, also known as "Senior Freeze." The program reimburses eligible senior and disabled residents for property tax increases. There are several requirements to be met including residency, age, and household income (not to exceed \$89,013 in 2018). Your application for the reimbursement must be filed before October 31, 2019. DID YOU KNOW?

The Florham Park Roller Rink on Ridgedale Avenue was built in 1924 as an auto repair garage. In 1930 the building became the home of New Jersey's largest indoor 18-hole miniature golf course. After several years, it was replaced by an antiques gallery and in 1937 the building was transformed into a roller-skating rink and later enlarged. The Roller Rink has become a landmark in Florham Park and continues to be attraction for children and families in Florham Park and throughout northern New Jersey.
