



**BOROUGH OF FLORHAM PARK  
ORDINANCE #22-3**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE  
BOROUGH OF FLORHAM PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF  
NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 24 OF CHAPTER  
238 ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC - STOP INTERSECTIONS”.**

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Florham Park and pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the intersections described are hereby designated as Stop Intersections. Stop signs shall be installed as provided herein.

**WHEREAS**, the Borough’s police department has recommended that the following intersections be designated as Stop Intersections in the interest of public safety.

**NOW THEREFORE**, Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Florham Park in the County of Morris, New Jersey, that the following intersections be hereby designated as Stop Intersections.

**Section 1 -**

**Intersection:**

Felch Road and Cross Lane

Felch Road and Circle Road

**Stop Sign(s) on:**

Cross Lane

Circle Road

**Section 2 -**

The effectiveness of this Ordinance is contingent on signs being erected as required by law.

**Section 3 -**

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, every person convicted of a violating a provision of this ordinance or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or imprisonment for a term not

exceeding fifteen (15) days or both.

**Section 4 -**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

**Section 5 -**

Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this ordinance be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this ordinance.

**Section 6 -**

This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
