## MCMUA Recycling Update: NO PLASTIC BAGS

Plastic bags continue to be a huge source of contamination in the recycling stream in our curbside towns. In an effort to eliminate this contamination, the MUA has created "No Plastic Bag" stickers. The MUA crew has been asked to place these on plastic bags they find at the curb. They will begin their tagging efforts in the coming weeks.





If a "No Plastic Bag" sticker is placed on your recyclables, the MUA crew will not return to pick them up until next collection day (in two weeks) when the plastic bags have been removed.

The MUA crew will be tagging with the pink stickers.

As a reminder, no plastic bags of any kind should be in the recycling container. As of January 2022, MUA **no longer accepts** shredded paper in the recycling container. Therefore, there are no exceptions to the plastic bag rule.
